Communications Strategy, supporting activist event promotions and assisting activist groups across Australia with content creation and communications dissemination.

This role will lead in coordinating the Activist Communications Team and its activities.

Main Responsibilities:

- Maintaining the Activist Communications Team inbox, including delegating e-mails and tasks to the relevant team members
- Reviewing outstanding tasks and following up with team members, activists or staff, as relevant
- Drafting and/or editing emails that promote activist activities and inspire recipients to take action across platforms such as Campaign Monitor and SupporterBase.
- Liaising with the Amnesty International staff, Activist Communications Team Lead and other activists and volunteers around the country to collate content for external communications, such as the People Powered Bulletin
- Ensuring all Activist Communications Team documents are updated and user friendly
